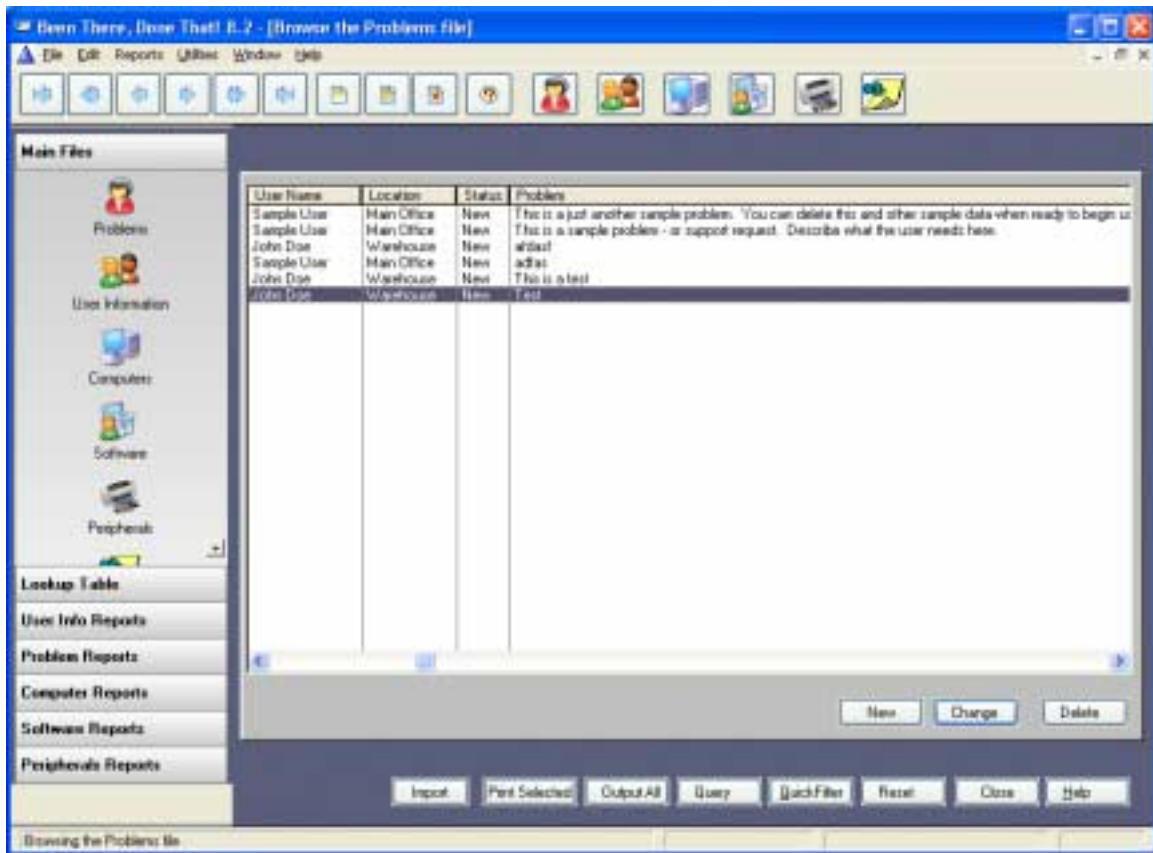


The next version of Been There, Done That! is under development. Some of the changes will be more readily apparent to users of version 8 than other changes. This document is intended to give you an idea of some of the changes planned for the next release.

The task panel from version 8.0 is being replaced in the next release, see screen shot below.



Below shows query operator option from version 8.0:

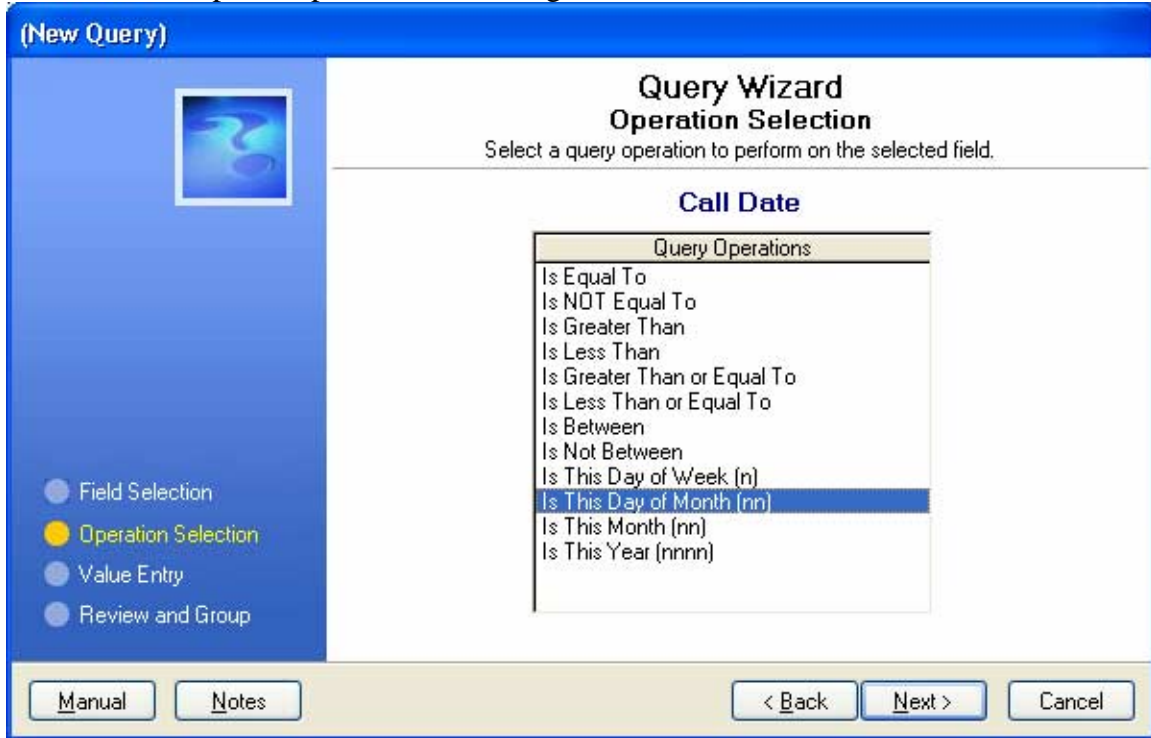


Now see some additional query options:



This screen shows the addition of “Is Between” and “Not Between” as a selection. This may be most useful in querying date field types, but can also be used as in this example, in non date field types.

There are new options specific to searching on date fields.



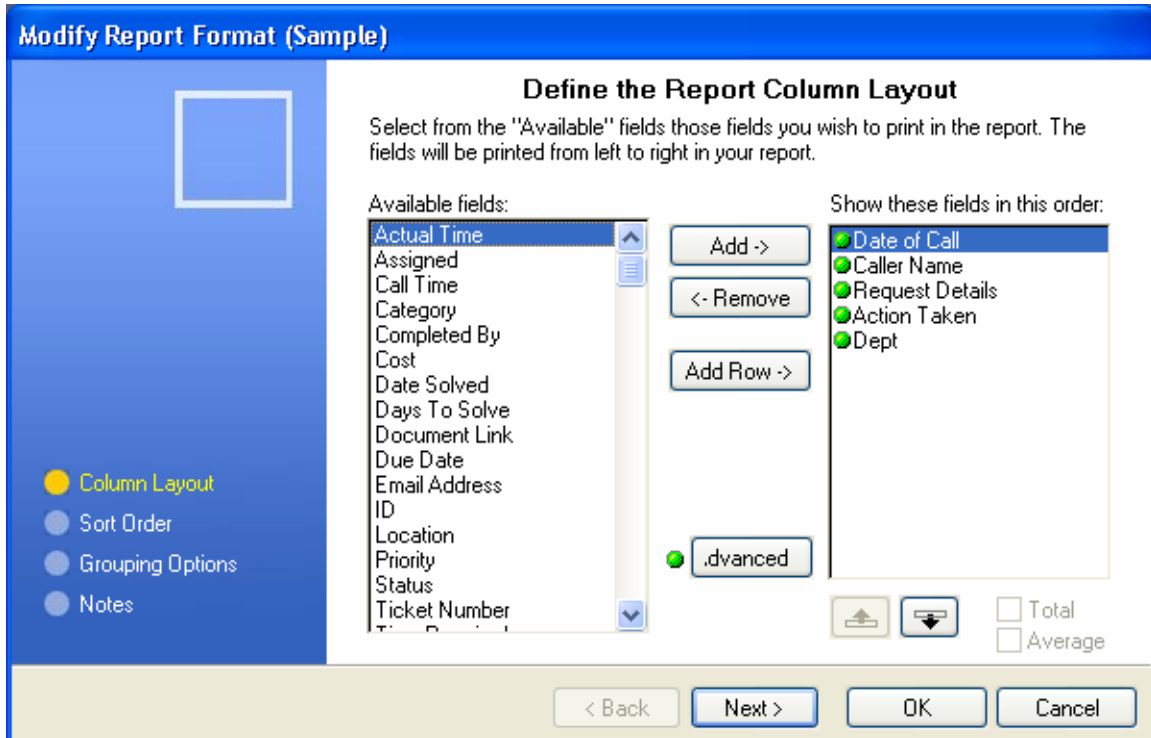
For example to quickly find records for the month of October you just choose Is this Month and in the next screen enter 10 – the number for that month.

The browse screens have additional buttons shown below:

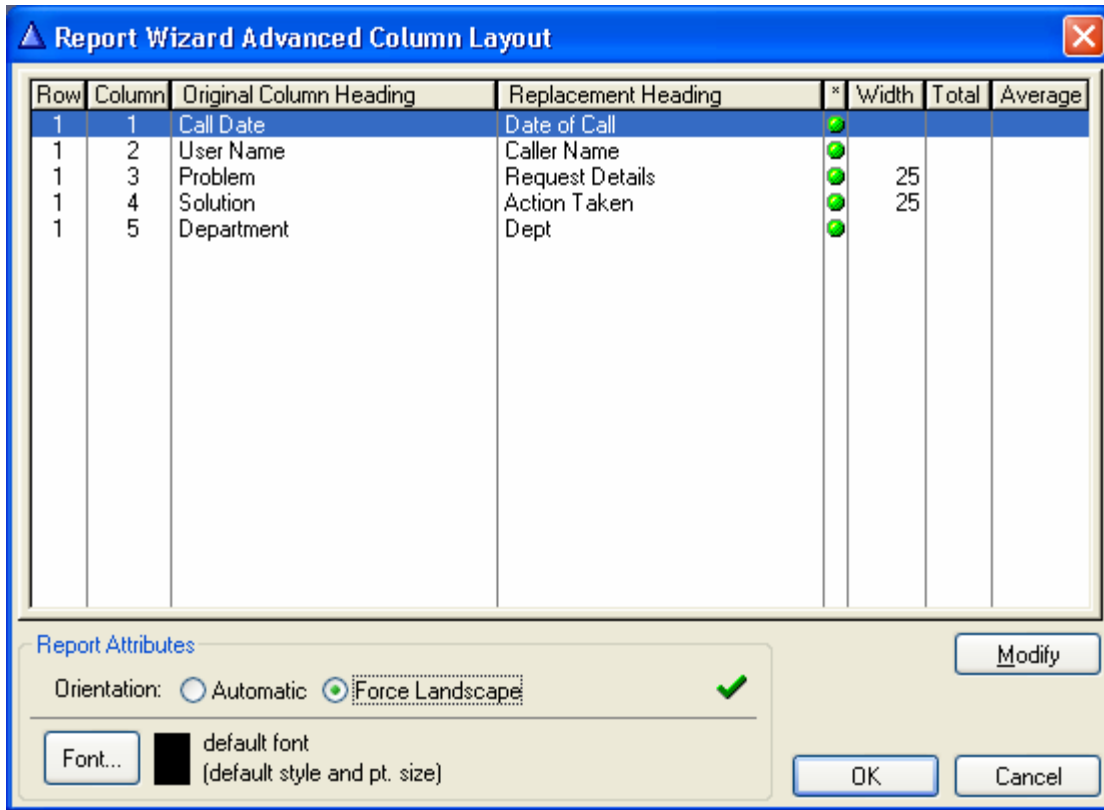
A new Quick Filter query button lets you select a field and then enter a value to search that field. This is an “equal to” match, not a contains or like type of condition. An Import button has been added to the main browse screens and this will allow you to import data not only from .csv files but from Excel, Access, or just about any ODBC DSN you have on your computer. More on this later... In addition, I have a new Output All button that will let you quickly export all the records as filtered and sorted directly to Microsoft Excel.



The Report Wizard is also much improved in this release. First of all there is no 8 line limit any more to long memo style fields. In addition, you can now change column headers and apply font changes to both data and column headers. See some of the screen shots below for the new report wizard look and feel.



A new add row button allows for those reports that have too many fields to include on a single row, even in landscape mode. This will allow for selection of more fields on a report.



Notice that not only can I now change the column headings, I can also specify a column width.

It is also now possible to include not just totals and average but a record count, for both the group but also the report level.

**Modify Report Format (Sample)**

**Group Heading and Footing Options**

You may choose to create group breaks on the first and second levels of the selected sort order. Group breaks are commonly used for displaying subtotals, record counts, and starting a new page for each group.
